General Information

- Our residential visits to Paxwold will take place from Monday 8th July to Tuesday 9th July for Class 2 and Tuesday 9th July to Wednesday 10th July for Class 1.
- ▶ We will leave school between 9.15 and 9.30 on the morning of each visit.

The Building

- ► Large welcoming entrance hall

- ► Two children's bedrooms bunkbeds
- ► One bedroom (no bunkbeds)
- ► Adult rooms near the children's bedrooms
- ▶ Toilets and disabled toilet
- Shower and bath facilities
- ► Garden area surrounding the bungalow
- ► Long driveway, perimeter fence and gates



Medical Form

- ► It is important that we have the medical forms completed asap
- List all medicines clearly on the form
- ► Any special requirements to be written on the medical form
- ► Clearly label all medicines and place in the medicines box on the morning of the trip
- ► Sun cream school will provide
- *If you are providing your child's own sun cream please clearly label the bottle and place in the medical box



Kit List

- One bag (if possible) clearly labelled, pull along wheels are helpful
- Try and pack pillow and sleeping bag in the main bag or attach onto the bag if possible
- ► Everything clearly labelled (even socks)
- Only pack what is on the kit list
- No money, sweets, cameras or additional toys
- ► Only one cuddly
- ▶ Not best clothes
- ► Ensure your child knows what has been packed
