### Spiers Bank House





Spiers Bank House is a residential centre within Cropton Forest (part of the North Yorkshire Moors National Park).

It is located in Cropton, Pickering.

It includes self-catering accommodation for 26 people in a mixture of small dormitories and double rooms.

We will take the children on a tour of the building at the start of the residential and discuss emergency procedures.





The site consists of three buildings, two containing dormitories and bedrooms, toilets and washing facilities. The third building is a cookhouse.



The site includes two large open spaces of grassland which offer the chance for a wide range of outdoor activities, team building exercises and ball games. There is also a nearby stream.

### • <u>Kit List</u>
