Dear Parents

Thank you to all of the parents who attended our open evenings this week. As ever, the staff enjoyed meeting with our families and discussing our children's achievements. Thank you also to those who took the time to complete our questionnaire. We are grateful for all of the positive feedback and equally grateful for the suggestions as to how you would like to see our provision made even better.

In September, we launched our new RE curriculum. Based upon the locally agreed syllabus, our new curriculum focuses on religions and worldviews. In order to provide the children with a broader understanding of different religions, last term we continued our programme of visitors speaking to the children about different faiths. Earlier this week, we were pleased to welcome a visitor from the Hull Mosque and Islamic Centre to speak about their Islamic faith. The children listened really well, asking thoughtful questions.

Yesterday, we celebrated World Book Day in school with the children. As part of this, the classes all took part in book related activities before joining together to share a staff video, published during the first lockdown, in which our staff shared short extracts from their favourite books. Reading is extremely popular in our school and the profile of this has been raised through our library that the children have the opportunity of accessing regularly. I am grateful to the Friends who have agreed to supplement our reading material further by donating £300 towards the cost of more books for the children.

Today, we held our first class assembly of this term. This was led by the children in Class 1 who shared songs, poems and information about the things they have been learning in class. It was a privilege to watch our youngest children perform so confidently in front of so many family and friends. We look forward to our next class assembly that is due to take place next Friday for the children in Class 2.

Next Wednesday, the FA are supporting the #Letgirlsplay initiative that promotes equal access to football for everyone. As part of this day, we will be showing our support by providing each class with a football session outside. This will be for both boys and girls to take part in. For this, the children will need their outdoor PE kit which should include a jumper in order to stay warm. They will also require a change of footwear.

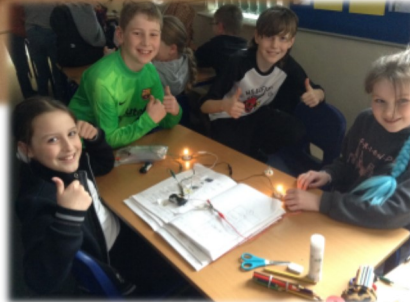
