Dear Parents,

This week, it has been great to welcome the children back to school after the half term holiday.

At the start of half term, we were pleased to launch our new website. This remains hosted at the existing address and will continue to be kept up to date with information about the school as well as our weekly newsletter. Alongside this, we have also increased the use of our Twitter account as a means of sharing the work we are doing. We will shortly be contacting parents to renew our existing photo permissions so that we can continue to share images and videos of the many exciting things taking place in school.

During the last academic year, the children in Class 3 and Class 4 took part in a local study supporting the work of West Wolds Slow the Flow. Following this, we took delivery this week of a weather station which will be permanently housed on our site.
