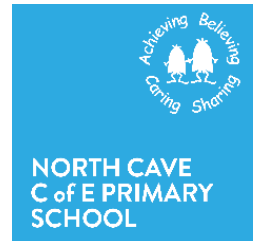

Dear Parents,

We were pleased to welcome representatives from 'Bubble Church' to the school on Monday. This is part of a new initiative to engage babies, toddlers, and young families. As part of this, families are invited to a puppet-packed, Jesus-centred, coffee-and-pastry-fuelled, 30 minute kids and families adventure that happens each month. The first of these is due to take place at All Saints Church, South Cave, on 10th December where they will be leading a 'dress up Nativity' at 9.15am.
