Dear Parents

We are really proud of the quality and range of our school dinners and these always prove popular. In order to take feedback from the children, this week, Miss Hurst and the Trust Catering Manager, Mrs Wood, met with our School Council to review our menu. The children spoke about their favourite meals, including fish Friday, spaghetti bolognese and curry. They also gave their opinions on some suggested changes. This included the introduction of several new meals including a Yorkshire pudding wrap with chicken and stuffing! Following this meeting, we are looking forward to our revised menu being launched shortly.

By now, the parents of the children in Year 6 should have received notification of their secondary school place allocation. In order to support transition and closer links with South Hunsley, we were visited last week by Mrs Blackledge, the Headteacher from South Hunsley School. As part of her morning with us, she visited each class and spent time with Class 4 answering the many questions they had. This visit was followed by a visit for our Year 6 pupils to South Hunsley on Tuesday to make pencil cases. Further transition events will follow, including a full day at South Hunsley at the end of June.

Yesterday, we celebrated World Book Day in school and it was great to see the vast range of costumes worn by the children. Reading is always high profile within our school and it was good to take the opportunity to celebrate the love of reading with the children.

As you will be aware, over the last couple of days, we have experienced unusually high levels of pupil absence due to sickness. Though this is particularly in Class 1, there are other cases across the school. In line with advice, we have implemented an enhanced cleaning programme and are also ensuring that the children wash their hands regularly. Please can you support us in limiting transmission by ensuring that any symptomatic children should be a full 48 hours clear of symptoms before returning to school. Thank you for your support with this. As a result of high levels of absence in Class 1, we decided to postpone our Class Worship for parents today and will let you know when this has been rearranged.

Next Friday, we will be marking Red Nose Day in school. In order to support this, the children may come to school in non school uniform and we will be encouraging them to dress in something red. We will be collecting voluntary donations on Friday morning with a suggested donation of £1.
