As a Trust and school, we are very conscious of the pressures felt by many families due to rising costs. I would particularly highlight the section relating to the free school meals, which parents can apply for in confidence. Though children in reception and Key stage 1 already receive free meals under the universal free school meals programme, I would urge parents who feel they may be eligible to apply as this also allows the school to access additional pupil premium funding to support the children in our care.

As you are aware, we are proud of the weather station that we have on site and regularly share data from this with our key stage 2 children. This is supporting their geography understanding and awareness of the conditions around us. As everyone negotiated the ice this morning, our weather station recorded a low of  $-5^{\circ}\text{C}$  at 8.28am! For those interested, a summary of the data can be found on our website.

Finally, today we say goodbye to our caretaker, Miss Bailey, who is leaving after 6 years at the school. We thank her for all she has done at the school and we wish her well for the future.
