Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, it has been great to welcome back all of our children from their Christmas holiday. The children returned to a WOW day in which they had a full day immersed in their new topics for this half term. The children in Class 1 and 2 will be learning about toys over time in History and the children in Class 3 and Class 4 will be studying Antarctica in Geography. The WOW days have proved really popular and are an important part of our curriculum that both the children and staff look forward to.

It seems appropriate that as Class 3 and Class 4 are studying extreme environments, this week we have seen some extreme temperatures outside! As you may be aware, as part of our work with the University of Hull and West Wolds Slow the Flow, several years ago we had a weather station installed on our school site. This provides a live feed that we can share with the children and also feeds to a national network of weather stations. From our weather station, we know that yesterday it was -7°C as the children arrived at school and the temperature reached a high of just 1°C!
