Dear Parents

This week the children in Year 6 took their KS2 SATs tests. The children worked extremely hard and did their best in each of the tests. We are extremely proud of them! Over the next two weeks, the children in Year 2 will be doing their KS1 SATs tests which are just one source of evidence gathered towards their KS1 SATs teacher assessment. They will complete four papers and we will endeavour to keep these as relaxed as possible for the children.

Next week, I am very much looking forward to accompanying the children in Class 3 on their residential visit to Spiers Bank House and Dalby Forest. This promises to be a great week with lots of fun activities planned in the locality of the house. We look forward to sharing photos of this on our return.

For the children in Class 1 and Class 2, you should today have received your letter regarding the residential visit to Paxwold in July. We believe taking all of our children away on a residential visit is a real privilege and taking our youngest children is particularly special. All visits require specific ratios in order to maintain safety and these ratios are higher for younger children. Maintaining ratios both off site and in school places a significant strain on our staffing and therefore this year, we have decided for the children to visit Paxwold for one night rather than two. This will still provide a magical experience and memories that will last a lifetime. The reduced length of stay is reflected in the cost which is substantially less than previous years.
