Dear Parents

On Monday, we were pleased to welcome Miss Digard to the school to work with our Year 5 children. Miss Digard is the Sustainability Lead for The Education Alliance and has kindly offered to work with our Year 5 children to improve our wildlife area. This will be done as part of the John Muir Award which is a UK wide environmental award, focusing on wild areas. A separate letter has gone to our Year 5 families this evening giving further details of the award and what the children will need on the days they will be taking part. This is an exciting venture and we look forward to sharing further details of this with you in due course.

Within school, we hold a reflective themed afternoon each term. These sometimes focus around a religious festival, for example Easter or Christmas. On other occasions they may focus on another theme such as our school values or vision. This afternoon, the children have considered their hopes and dreams for the new year, with a focus on hopes for themselves, their friends, the school and the world. This has been done in mixed age house groups with the children travelling to one of four stations. The children have thoroughly enjoyed working with children other than those in their class groupings and have come up with some really sensible and considerate ideas.
