Dear Parents,

This week, we have enjoyed welcoming parents on to site for our open evenings. Thank you to all of the parents who took the time to complete a questionnaire and for both the positive feedback and suggestions as to things you would like to see improved. As the children in Year 6 will be having a separate consultation day, questionnaires will be made available at these so that we can canvass additional views. If you have not attended either of these events and would like to complete a questionnaire, please call in to the school office.

Last year, we changed our assessment system in school and simplified the way in which we assess children, bringing our judgements into line with the way in which children are assessed at the end of KS1 and KS2. We now assess children as to whether they are working at, above or below age related expectations. Parents of children currently in Year 1 and Year 3 will have had statutory assessment results in the summer which give up to date assessment information. Parents in all other year groups, except reception, will be given a summary of their child's attainment in reading, writing and maths at their appointment. If you have any questions about this, please contact us.

I have been pleased to receive positive feedback for our first aid training that we led with the children in Years 1, 2, 5 and 6 last week. Within this, the children were taught some basic first aid skills and were also taught what to do in an emergency. It is our intention to repeat this training every two years so that all children will receive training in Years 1 and 2 and also when they reach Years 5 and 6.

As you are aware, numbers across the school are continuing to rise. We have already received some interest from parents who are looking for a place for their child for September 2023. We will be holding an open event for prospective families on Saturday 5th November between 10am and 1pm. Further details of this will follow but please do encourage anyone with a child due to start in September 2023 to save this date. We are proud of our school and are very happy to show people around at an alternative time if this is more convenient.

Finally, I would like to welcome Mrs Cattell to the school. Mrs Cattell will be working with us as a lunchtime supervisor. The children have already made her feel very welcome!

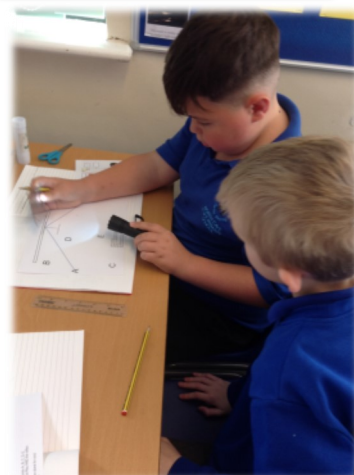
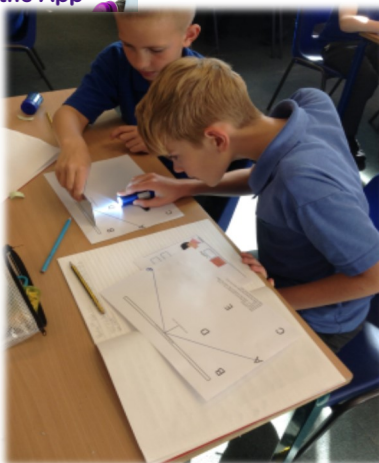
