Dear Parents

This children in Year 6 have completed their SATs tests. The children's attitude to these have been excellent and we are extremely proud of the way each of them approached each day and did their best. We will communicate the results to parents once they are released in July but for now, will look forward to more exciting events such as sports day, productions and residential!

Within this newsletter, you will find a number of dates for your diary for the final half term of this year. Please note there is a slight change to our Paxwold dates. In order to help us maintain supervision ratios, we have decided to go in the smaller year groups rather than full classes. 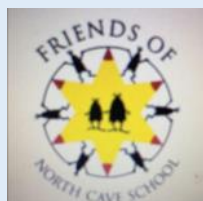
Class Four
