

Dear Parents

On Tuesday, we were pleased to take a team of Year 3 and Year 4 children to South Hunsley to take part in some football matches against other local schools. For some of these children, it was the first time they had represented our school and it was good to be able to provide them with this opportunity. The children played well and thoroughly enjoyed the experience. Next week, our programme of interschool sport continues with Years 5 and 6 benchball on Tuesday and the 'small schools football tournament' on Wednesday.

Yesterday evening, I met with the Friends of the School to discuss forthcoming fund-raising events. We are very much looking forward to our film night this evening and also the school Christmas disco in December. As ever, I am grateful to the Friends for their support and for giving their time generously to support our children. It is through their fund raising that we are able to provide additional activities and resources to enhance our children's experiences.

We were pleased to see so many children wearing odd socks in school yesterday. This was a symbolic way of recognising and celebrating the fact that everyone is different. Alongside this, each class has spoken about anti bullying and strategies for preventing bullying and dealing with problems should they occur. A key strategy in our school is the use of learning logs in Class 3 and Class 4. These provide an important opportunity for a dialogue between the children and adults in the class and allow the children to report any worries they may have. The children are allowed to access these at any time and often allow small worries to be dealt with before they escalate.

Today, we celebrated Children in Need Day in school. This provided an opportunity for the children to come to school in non-school uniform. Thank you to everyone for your generous donations. Together, we raised over £135.

Next week, you will be receiving a letter relating to a school choir that we are intending to launch. Led by Miss Hodgson and Mrs Grafton, this will take place on a Monday evening after school between 3.30 and 4.15pm. There will be no charge for this club which is in addition to the football club, book club, running club and Jesus and Me club already taking place.

Next week we look forward to starting our new topic: Volcanoes and Mountains.


