#### Dear Parents

Earlier this week, we were pleased to take a team of Year 5 and 6 children to South Hunsley to take part in a benchball competition. The children competed against a number of local schools and represented our school extremely well. We now look forward to taking a team from Years 3 and 4 to a benchball competition next week.

This week is national anti-bullying week. As part of this, all of the classes have completed some work looking at bullying, how this makes people feel and how to report this if it happens. It is important that all schools are alert to the signs of this as bullying can happen in any school in a number of different ways. It is vitally important that children feel comfortable reporting any concerns that they have and in our school, the children in all year groups are encouraged to talk to a trusted adult. Learning logs are also a valuable way of communicating any concerns in Key Stage 2. The children are allowed to write in these at any time and this provides a communication tool between the children and adults. These allow children to express any concerns and worries and provide a log of any repetitive behaviours.

Today has been Children in Need day and the children have enjoyed coming to school in non-school uniform. Thank you for the generous donations we have received. Together, we raised £176 for this valuable cause.

It has been good to see so many parents and friends support our class assemblies this term. Today we have been thoroughly entertained by the children in Class 3 who have led two class assemblies for families and friends. This was based upon their learning this term and involved the children sharing their work and also several songs, including one in French. We believe that performances are a really important part of our curriculum and we look forward to the children in Class 1 and Class 2 sharing their Christmas performance in December.

Next week, the children in Years 4 and 5 will be taking part in swimming lessons at Goole Leisure Centre. These will take place each Tuesday over a ten week period. Please ensure that you have returned your permission slip for this by Monday if you have not yet done so.

Though the summer feels a long way away, we are already planning the residential visits that we are proud to offer every year group. We are pleased to confirm that we have now booked Kingswood Dearne Valley for the children in Class 4. This will take place between Wednesday 24th May and Friday 26th May 2023.
