In addition, in the week commencing 9th June, the children in Year 1 will be participating in the phonics screening check. Again, the children are well prepared for this and the format of the assessment. A parents meeting will be held on Monday 2nd June at 3.40pm to explain the format of the assessment.

Finally, as you are aware, we were sad to say goodbye to Mrs Revell who left our school yesterday after nine years at the school. We would like to thank Mrs Revell for all she has done whilst with us and wish her well for the future.


