Dear Parents

On Tuesday, we were delighted to welcome the Bishop of Hull to our school following an invitation from our children. As part of this visit, our Worship Squad led collective worship before the Bishop toured each of the classrooms, meeting and talking to the children as they took part in a mixed age activity linked to Lent. The Worship Squad then met with the Bishop to ask some questions about her role and share some pancakes. This was a really memorable experience and we are grateful to the Bishop for her time.

Last term, we wrote to parents to remind everyone about the yellow zig-zags outside school. Thank you to everyone who observes these during the restricted times, even though it can mean parking further away from school.
