Dear Parents

Over the weekend, we were pleased to see work start on the installation of two new planters to the rear of our building as part of our work to promote sustainability and flood prevention. Arranged for us by our Friends at West Wolds Slow the Flow, the planters will be attached to two drainpipes and will utilise rain water from the roof to water the plants. This in turn will limit the water entering the drains system and contributing to flooding. The planters will be completed in the coming weeks and we look forward to using these with our children.

This week, we have continued with our programme of visitors to support our curriculum for Religion and Worldviews and we were pleased to welcome a Humanist who spoke to the children about his view of the world. Next week, we look forward to welcoming a visitor from a local synagogue to talk to Class 1 and Class about the Jewish faith.

Yesterday, the Friends of the School held their AGM. It was great to see this so well attended by both current members of the committee and interested parents. The Friends organise some excellent events for our children and I am grateful to them for the funds that they raise to provide additional experiences and resources for our children.

As we approach the end of term, we want to make you aware of some of the events that are taking place next week.

On Monday 27th March, the children in Class 3 will be visiting Beverley Minster to take part in REaction. This is a rearranged visit from this week.

On Tuesday 28th March, we will be holding our Easter Service at 10.30am at All Saints Church. This will be led by the children and all family and friends are invited to attend. After school, we will be holding our Easter disco. This takes place between 3.30 and 4.30pm for Class 1 and Class 2 and between 4.45pm and 5.45pm for Class 3 and Class 4.

On Thursday 30th March, the children in Class 1 and Class 2 will be taking part in an Easter Bonnet parade at 9.15am and parents and friends are welcome to watch. The children will be making bonnets in school however are welcome to wear one made at home if they prefer. We will also be holding a decorated egg competition for the children in Class 3 and Class 4 should they wish to take part. These should be brought into school at the start of Thursday and will be displayed in the hall. There will be prizes for the best home-made bonnets and decorated eggs.

The school closes for Easter at the end of Thursday 30th March and we return to school on Monday 17th April.

Looking ahead to next term, we are pleased to now be able to confirm the dates for our Class 3 residential visit to Spiers Bank House. This will take place during the week commencing 15th May. A separate letter with the details of this has been sent to parents today.
