Yesterday, we were pleased to present our new Wellbeing Ambassadors in Year 6 with their lanyards. The Wellbeing Ambassadors have been trained by MIND to provide support to other children in school should they feel upset or need someone to talk to on the playground. We are proud of the continued success of our work with MIND and the way in which this is helping to empower and support both small groups and individuals. This compliments the ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support) programme that is already well established within school.

We are continually developing our curriculum in order to ensure that it continues to enthuse and challenge the children. In order to deepen their understanding across a range of curriculum areas, next week we will be launching our 'golden thread of skills' with the children. 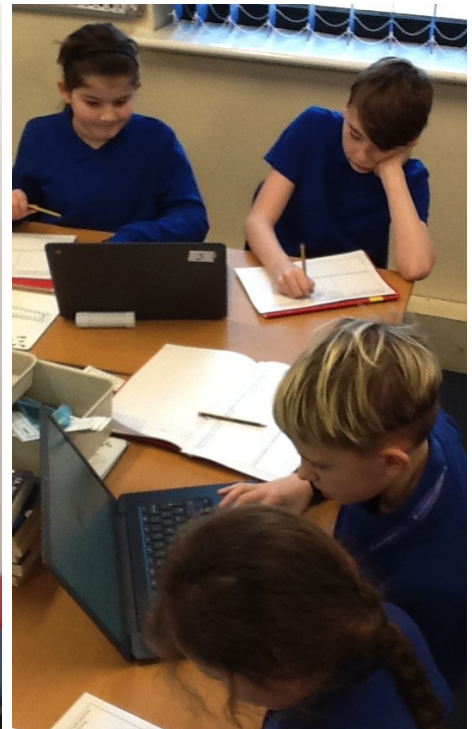
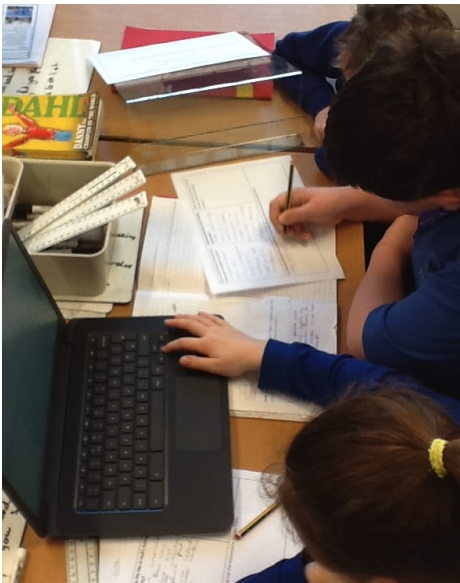
