Dear Parents

On Tuesday, we were pleased to see interschool sport resume for this term with a football tournament for the children in Years 3 and 4. The children enjoyed playing a range of local schools and represented us extremely well. Well done to all of the children that took part.

This week has also seen the children in Year 5 start their work with Miss Digard towards the Discovery Award as part of the John Muir Awards. As part of their work, the children have been thinking about how we can improve our wildlife area and have begun the process of tidying some of the areas. Work towards this award will take place each Monday afternoon this term and the children will continue to need appropriate clothing for this.

As children develop, one of the most important skills they will learn is to read. An important part of developing this is acquiring a secure phonic knowledge. Within school, we place a significant emphasis upon developing this skill and as a result, all of our children in Class 1 and Class 2 take part in a daily phonics lesson as well as being exposed to phonics activities during the day. In order that you can support your children at home with this, we will be holding two phonics meetings for parents that explain our approach to phonics as well as strategies to support your child. These will both take place on 23rd February with the first focusing on supporting the children in reception to develop a firm phonics knowledge and the second explaining the format of the statutory phonics screening check for Year 1 pupils that will take place in June.

We are pleased that our before and after school provision continues to be extremely popular. Please can I remind all parents to ensure that your child is booked into each session so that we can ensure that each session is appropriately resourced.

Finally, as you are aware from our letter earlier in the week, the first strike, organised by the NEU, is due to take place on Wednesday. As things stand, we continue to anticipate being open to all children as usual.

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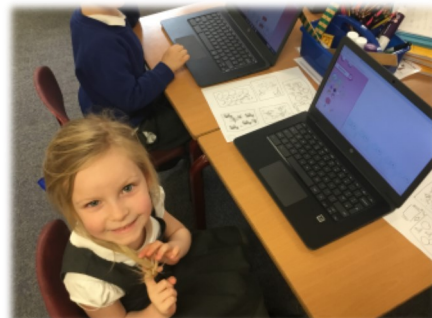
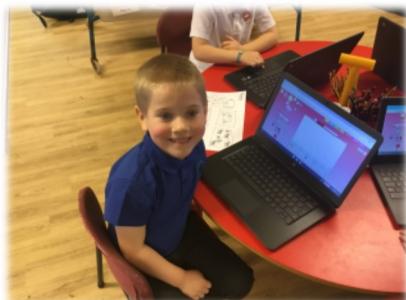
