Breakfast Club

As mentioned in a previous newsletter, we are pleased to have been accepted as an 'early adopter' school for the Government's free breakfast club initiative. Through this scheme, school will provide a free healthy breakfast to all pupils that take part. As the scheme requires schools to provide up to 30 minutes for breakfast, this will start at 8.30am each morning and finish at 9am when registers are taken and the school day formally begins. In order to allow us to plan, we are asking parents to book for either the usual paid club (at a slightly reduced rate to reflect the free period) or, for the free, shorter club, starting at 08:30. This scoping exercise is essential to allow the safe operation of the club as there is a significant difference in the resources and supervision needed depending upon the numbers attending. Bookings for the free club will move to ParentPay shortly, however for the first week, please can you book using the
