



A Remote Learning Strategy...

At North Cave CE Primary School, we are committed to providing a rich and exciting curriculum for all of our children. During the period of full or partial school closure, it is vital that the school has the procedures and infrastructure in place to ensure that our children can fully access the curriculum either at home or at school.

In order to ensure a comprehensive curriculum when learning remotely, we provide:-

Three hours a day of learning at EYFS and KS1.

Four hours a day of learning at KS2.

How we provide remote education

Remote education can take a number of forms:-

- Online tasks
- Online games and resources
- Video demonstrations
- 'Live' lessons
- Printed resources
- Regular feedback

Daily work is provided for each child through Google Classroom with 'live' lessons and interaction provided through Google Meet.

Supporting all children to get online

We recognise that not all children have access to the equipment needed to access online learning. Where this is the case, we lend children the equipment they need or make provision for them to attend learning in school.

Regular contact and interaction with an adult in school

As part of our online offer, we provide daily check in sessions online for all children working remotely at home. These allow us to stay in touch and ensure that the children have regular interaction with the adults in school and their peers. In addition, we also phone home where it is felt that a child would benefit from additional contact.
