Dear Parents

Following our Governing Body meeting last night, I am pleased to confirm that after consultation we have now adopted our new uniform policy. As part of this, we will be introducing a minor change to the logo as it is displayed on all new uniform. This will now incorporate the words 'achieving and believing' as well as the school name. A proof of the new logo can be seen below.



Following parental feedback, this logo will be consistent on all uniform items however will be displayed in white writing on book bags and PE bags.

Our new uniform list is listed below:-

<u>Uniform</u>

- Royal blue jumper or cardigan with or without school logo
- Royal blue or white polo shirt with or without school logo
- Dark grey trousers, shorts or knee length skirt/pinafore
- Blue and white checked dress
- White/grey/black socks or grey tights

Footwear

- A pair of plain indoor shoes, preferably sandshoes or plimsolls (no slippers / boots / branded trainers)
- A pair of outdoor shoes, preferably black/brown school shoes

P.E. kit

- Royal blue T-shirt with or without school logo
- Black shorts
- Dark coloured plain tracksuit top/sweatshirt (for cold weather) or school 'hoodie' (with school logo)









- Dark coloured plain tracksuit bottoms (for cold weather)
- Trainers

Jewellery

- No jewellery to be worn in school with the exception of a small watch. A small stud earring may be worn if the child has their ears pierced.
- Due to health and safety, watches and earrings must be removed for PE. If your child cannot remove them by themselves, tape needs to be provided and the earring must be covered. The child will need to apply the tape themselves.
- Large smart watches or watches used to communicate messages are not to be worn.

Accessories

- Due to health and safety, long hair should be tied up.
- Plain hairbands, plain bobbles or a plain small bow may be worn in hair.
- No extreme hairstyles.
- No make-up or nail varnish.

In line with parent feedback, we have agreed to move to a **new uniform supplier** who is local, slightly cheaper than our current supplier and also aims to deliver on orders within 14 days. Our new supplier's website can be found below.

Our new school range will be going live on this website later this week. Orders placed may take up to 14 days in busy periods.

Please note, we will no longer be using our old supplier - only orders placed with our new supplier will contain our new logo.

As already expressed in our consultation letter, we do not wish any changes to our uniform to cause unnecessary inconvenience or expense. For this reason, we have continued to allow uniform without a logo to be worn and have also ensured that our new supplier is able to provide our uniform more quickly and also more cheaply. We will also be allowing a significant period of transition of at least a year during which time our existing uniform will remain valid.
