Following the sad news yesterday, we held a special collective worship this morning for all of the children in Years 1 to 6. Within this, we expressed our sadness for the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. We also talked about some of the many things that she had achieved during her life. Within the classrooms, staff have been ready to answer any questions that the children may have in a sensitive and age-appropriate manner and will continue to do so over the coming weeks.

It was good to welcome the children back to school earlier this week following the summer holiday. It was particularly great to welcome all of our new starters and their parents to school and see all of the reception children settle so well. Numbers across the school are continuing to rise and it is pleasing that we were able to welcome 21 children to our reception this year.

As you will be aware, significant work has taken place to our buildings and grounds and this has included a new heating system, a new roof and redecoration of the office, staffroom and part of the Class 1 teaching area. Additionally we have removed the tyres to the front of the building, the old climbing frame and bridge to the rear of the building. We also now have different tables in the lunch hall which allow the children to be seated more easily. All of this work has improved our facilities and I am grateful to all of the staff who worked hard in returning the building to normal in time for the children's arrival on Tuesday.

Our school lunches continue to be popular and this week we have launched a new menu for this term. Our kitchen continues to be led by our cook, Miss Hurst. We are pleased to also welcome Mrs Miller to the school who will be working as our kitchen assistant.

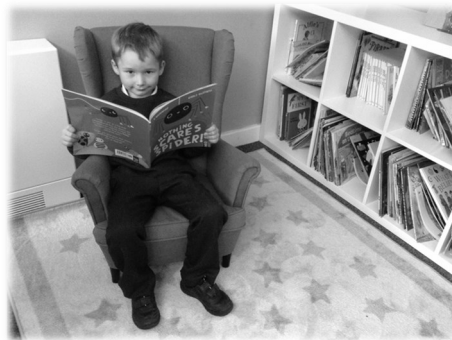
