Dear Parents.

We are pleased that the work to our grounds and buildings is nearing completion and today has seen turf put down on the areas previously containing our tyres and climbing frame. Once complete, this will give additional spaces for the children to play at the front and rear of the building. We are hoping that work to the roof will be completed next week and once this is done, we will be able to return to using our usual access points to the building for Class 3 and Class 4.
